



## HiSET/GED EDUCATION OPTIONS

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1. To obtain a HiSET/GED, Parent / Guardian must present to a Supervisor of Child Welfare and Attendance documentation of student participation in one of the following State Approved categories:
  - pregnant or actively parenting
  - incarcerated or adjudicated
  - chronic physical or mental illness
  - institutionalized or living in residential facility
  - family or economic hardship
2. Parent/Guardian must present a letter of acceptance from the institution the student will be enrolling (ONLY exception - LA Technical College).
3. Upon completion, student and Parent/Guardian must present the waiver to the HiSet/GED Program for official enrollment.
4. For approval and/or additional information, contact a Supervisor of Child Welfare and Attendance.

## ADDITIONAL EDUCATION SERVICES

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Caddo Parish Public Schools has an established partnership with the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) Youth Services Program designed for out of school youth ages 16-24. The program offers career development and services that lead to training and employment for youth in Caddo Parish. 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The local school superintendent or his/her designee may approve the request for exiting public or home school without requesting action from BESE. Students seeking to exit school to enroll in adult education, who are enrolled in a formal education setting other than a public K-12 institution, may request a waiver from the instructional agency head or his/her designee. Mandatory attendance components shall be met in all of the above circumstances.
